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PRELIMINARIES:

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- > The Presiding Officer, Engr. Ranulfo D. Lopez, BAC Chairman called the meeting to order at 10:00 o'clock in the morning.
- Ronald A. Sollano, BAC TWG Member led the invocatory prayer.
- Zobaida P. Castro, BAC Secretariat Member did the roll call and informed the presiding officer that the attendance was in quorum. She also recognized the interested bidders, guests and visitors who were in the meeting.
- The Presiding Officer declared that they are in quorum. He then read the agenda of the meeting.
- Noli S. Doromal, MPA, BAC Member moved to approve the agenda and it was duly seconded by Jose Arvin F. Eruela, BAC Member.
- The Presiding Officer requested the BAC Secretariat to read the minutes of the previous meeting.
- Noli S. Doromal, MPA moved to dispense with the reading of the previous minutes and approving the minutes of the previous minutes dated April 13, 2023 it was duly seconded by Jose Arvin F. Eruela.

PART I. PRE- BID CONFERENCE

The Presiding Officer, Engr. Ranulfo D. Lopez informed the body about the project subject for the Pre-Bid Conference, to wit:

- The Presiding Officer, then informed the body that the BAC received Letter of Intent from two contractors namely RG Salanatin Construction, Inc., Davao City and FFJJ Construction, Notre Dame Village, Cotabato City.
- The Presiding Officer informed the body about the need for pre-bid conference as required under Section 22 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184. He then read the pertinent provisions and discussed the subjet matter.
- > He presented through Power Point Presentation the contents of the Bid documents.
- The Chairman told the bidders that they must read all the details in the bid documents.
- Starting with the Invitation to Bid, the Project title Construction of Mega Market, Kitacubong, Alamada (Design & Build Scheme), the Contract duration is 540 calendar days and other requirements stipulated in the invitation to bid.
- ➤ Bidding documents are available at the BAC Office starting April 12 to May 2, 2023 in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos Only (PhP50,000.00).
- Manual submission of Bids will be on or before May 2, 2023 until 10:00 o'clock in the morning.
- > Late bids shall not be accepted.
- > The Presiding Officer asked the interested bidders present if they are well aware of the details of the Invitation to Bid.
- > He then discussed the other details of the Invitation to Bid.
- He also tackled the Instruction to Bidders which include the scope of bid, funding information, bidding requirements and others as stated on the Bid Documents emphasizing on the opening and preliminary examination of bids and detailed evaluation particularly on the two step procedure and the pass and fail criteria that if the bid failed the criteria it is outright disqualified.
- The Bid Data Sheet was also read including all the requirements thereto.
- > The General Condition of the Contract and Special Conditions of the contrat were also discussed.
- > The Presiding Officer who is also the Municipal Engineer discussed the specifications and parameters in details as stated on the Bid Documents
 - * Including the demolition and transfer of Kitacubong Covered Court at Purok 5, Kitacubong

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- *Septic tank and treatment plant
- *Solar system for brownout/perimeter light
- *Building to be constructed where the two(2) storey commercial building, dry and wet market, agricultural and hardware building and other details
- > He also emppasized the project requirements particularly the aircon and elevator outlet for future use.
- > That these requirements and other details must be included in their design.
- That the Two storey building must use pre-engineered designed building (steel) not concrete for speedy construction schedule. It must be steel and bolted not welded
- > Detailed construction plan must be submitted 15 days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed.
- The implementation arrangement was also discussed particularly on the demolition of buildings.
- The Chairman discussed the eligibility requirements like updated Philgeps and other technical requirements particularly on the SLCC of Design and Construction of Public Market (Design and Build Scheme) completed within 5 years before the submission and receipt of bids must be in the amount of One Hundred Fifteen Million Pesos (PhP115,000,000,00) and above.
- ➤ He also discussed the qualifications of design & construction personnel and the warranty guarantee.
- > He also discussed the Bill of Quantities.
- The Chairman also discussed in details the checklist of Technical and Financial Documents which is also attached in the bidding documents.
- The Presiding Officer also informed the interested bidders that the technicial envelope shall be opened first and if found eligible, bidders will have the presentation through power point, if the bidders pass, the financial envelope will be opened.

OPEN FORUM:

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- The Chairman declares the floor open for clariffication.
- Mr. Cari Mark dela Cruz of FFJJ Construction queried regarding the design presentation, if they will only present the design or include the structural and estimates or other engineeering matters.
- Engr. Lopez asked him if it is their first time to participate in a design and build project, he informed him that the LGU has an area of 19,000 sq.m, with the requirements based on the LGU needs and data gathered, they will have to design the buildings, and other stuctures based on those data as provided in the bidding documents.
- Engr. Lopez also informed him to comply the technical requirements and if they pass they will undergo the presentation.
- Engr. Mark asked again if what software will be used for the presentation is it Photoshop, PDF or Power Point.
- > Engr. Lopez answered Power Point for presentation and PDF for estimates.
- Representative from RG Salanatin Construction, Mr Manuel Villarias asked about the trasfer of COTELCO powerlines within the public market, he also asked why the need to transfer?
- Engr. Lopez answered that the lines will be transferred within the four corners of the public market. He also informed that during the lay-outing the lines might cross into other buildings.
- > Engr. Villarias was also concerned about the private lines inside the public market.
- > Engr. Lopez answered that the private electric lines connected to the post inside the construction area will be transferred.
- Engr. Gargar of FFJJ Construction asked if there were illegal settlers within the public market and if they have to pay for the buildings or is it included in the budget.
- > Engr. Lopez answered that they will not be paid but it will depend upon the strategy of the contractor on how to go about it.
- > Engr. Gargar said it will be an additional cost on their part.
- 173 Engr. Lopez said that the LGU has already issued demolition order and there is no budget for that.
 - > There were no more questions from the prospective bidders.

- Since no more question asked by the interested bidders, Noli S. Doromal reminded them to check the the bid amount in words and figures being offered.
 - Jose Arvin F. Eruela also reminded the interested bidders to properly put the tabbings for easy checking.
 - Engr. Ranulfo D. Lopez then reminded that LATE bids shall not be accepted.
 - > The presiding officer ended the Pre-Bid Conference.

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PART II. ADJOURNMENT

There being no more business to be taken, Jose Arvin F. Eruela moved for the adjournment of the meeting, seconded by Engr. Lemuel S. Turan.

The meeting adjourned at 12:05 in the afternoon.
